

Beginnings 2 - Adam & Eve Alternate Review Game

These activities can be done while the kids remain seated. That helps to keep the group from getting too riled up!

To Prepare:

Fold 12 sheets of colored construction paper or card stock in half and number them on the outside from 1-12

Inside each one write one of these activities:

- Pretend to blow up a big balloon until it pops!
- Do a rocket countdown to "blastoff" starting with 10!
- Clap: 3 soft, 3 loud, 13 soft!
- Reach over your head and touch one ear, then the other!
- Blink one eye then the other while counting to 12!
- Touch your toes, knees, waist, and shoulders, then back down to your toes!
- Twiddle your thumbs while counting to ten, then reverse direction and count to 15!
- Cover your eyes and say the alphabet fast!
- Turn your head around as far as you can, like an owl, then go the other way!
- Pretend to rub gobs of sunscreen on your face and arms!
- Stretch and try to touch the ceiling with your right hand, then your left!
- Pretend to swat 4 mosquitoes in the air with your hands!

To Play:

Divide the group into two teams (or just play for fun). Mix up the cards and fan them out with the numbers down. Ask for a volunteer from the first team, who picks one of the cards and turns it over to see which question will be asked.

If the child answers correctly, that team wins points equal to the number of the question times 1,000. Then the card is opened and the child reads it and leads the group in performing it. The team with the most points (after an equal number of turns for each team) wins.
