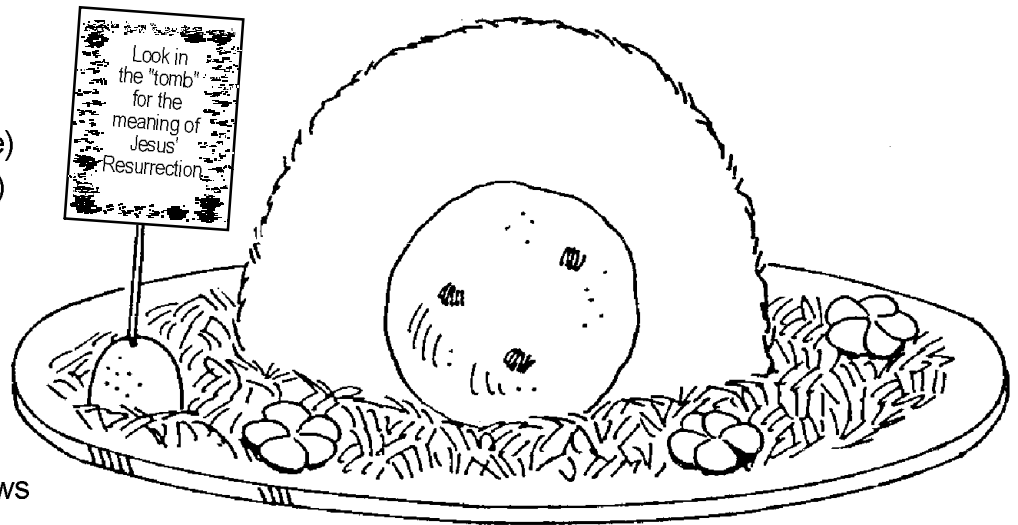


Craft Project: make an edible Resurrection scene

Jesus' Resurrection happened the third day after He died for us on the cross. He came back to life from the dead! Then after 40 days He went back to His Father in heaven and He is alive forever! If we believe in Jesus we will live forever with Him. When He comes back someday we will get wonderful new bodies like His that can never die. When you make this scene, remember that Jesus is alive!

What you need:

- white Hostess Sno-Ball
- plastic knife
- small paper plate (dessert size)
- flat cookie (like a vanilla wafer)
- scissors
- toothpick
- tape
- gumdrop
- shredded coconut
- green food coloring
- colored miniature marshmallows



What to do:

1. Cut a hole in the Sno-Ball to make an entrance to the tomb. Be sure that the hole you cut is smaller than the cookie. Scoop out some of the cake and filling and set the tomb on the plate. (Be sure to save what you scoop out, you can eat it later!)
2. Now cut out the signs from this page. First tape the one that says "Look in the 'tomb' for the meaning of Jesus' Resurrection" to a toothpick, and stick the toothpick into a gumdrop. Then fold the other sign in half and stand it inside the tomb. If it won't fit, hollow out the Sno-Ball a little more.
3. You can make your tomb look like it is in a garden by adding grass and flowers. To make the grass, stir a few drops of green food color into the coconut. Sprinkle the coconut grass around the tomb. Now to make the flowers, slice the marshmallows and put them on the grass in the shape of flowers.
4. Finally, lean the cookie against the tomb so it looks like the stone that sealed it. Have your family and friends look inside to find the meaning of Jesus' Resurrection.
